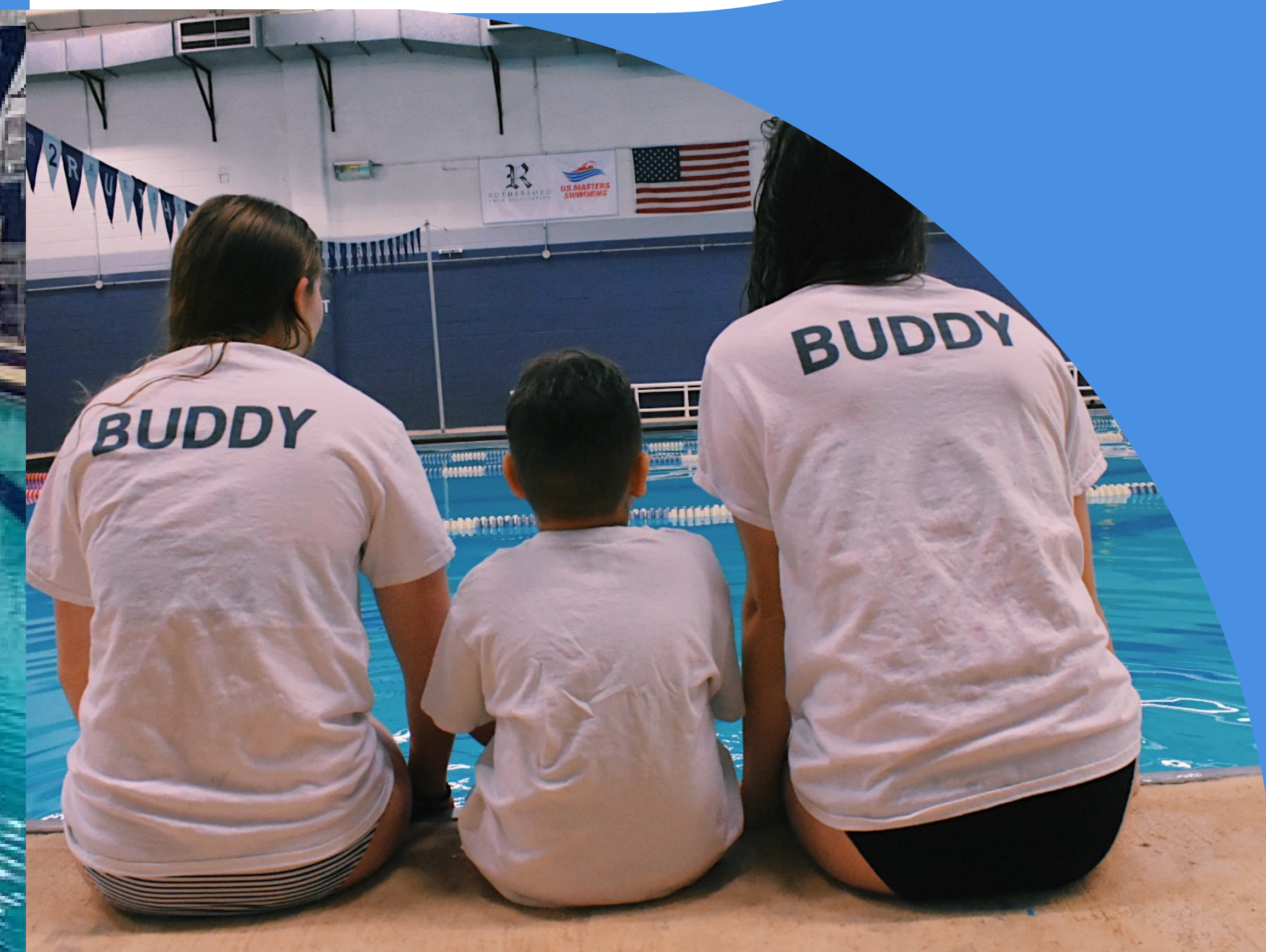

# COVID-19 Reopening Guide

Standard Operating  
Procedures





## Facility Procedures

- All visitors are required to enter on Elliott Place, one at a time, and exit on the Fairview Avenue side of the building
- All patrons must enter and exit the pool in the shallow end
- There will be no seating area inside the facility. All benches will remain outside and staff will be required to sanitize after every use
- All high touch areas, including door handles, light switches, lifeguard equipment and outdoor benches will be sanitized frequently
- Restrooms will be locked by staff. Access must be requested and is limited to one person at a time
- The locker room is closed. An outdoor shower is available for swimmers to rinse off before entering the facility

## Social Distance Ambassador

- A social distance ambassador role has been established to monitor and encourage safe practices for all swimmers and staff throughout their time at the facility
- The ambassador is also responsible for checking temperatures of all patrons with a non-contact thermometer before entering the facility

## General Procedures

- Patrons are required to enter the facility on Elliott Place and exit the facility on Fairview Avenue
- Upon entering the facility, all visitors will be screened for fever or symptoms associated with COVID-19 --- temperatures of 99.9 or higher will not be allowed into the facility
- Our building capacity is limited to 25% or 30 people at any one time
- Pool capacity is 30 people at any one time requiring all swimmers to reserve a time and lane prior to entering the facility
- All visitors two years or older are required to wear a face mask to enter the facility. Face coverings will also be worn while not in the pool and when a social distance of six feet cannot be maintained
- All sessions will end with a 40-minute open swim to allow staff the opportunity to sanitize the pool between sessions. The entire facility will be routinely cleaned
- Goggles are allowed however no other equipment will be permitted inside
- Towels and other equipment provided by the facility will only be available to one individual at a time and properly disinfected after use
- Starting blocks will be off limits for now
- Private lessons will be provided for competitive swimmers only. The restart date for group swim lessons is awaiting further guidance

## Staff Procedures

- All staff members will undergo daily health screenings including temperature checks
- Staff inside and outside the facility will be required to wear face masks at all times
- Lifeguards on active duty are not required to wear face masks
- All staff are certified on COVID-19 awareness as well as facility cleaning and sanitizing procedures
- Personal protective equipment (PPE) is available on site to ensure each staff member has two reusable face covers. Latex gloves will be provided daily and hand sanitizer is available to all staff members
- Staff members are required to stay home if they are not feeling well and notify their supervisor
- If a staff member forgets to bring in their face mask, extra supplies are available to ensure every staff member has one

## Emergency Procedures

If a guest shows signs of feeling ill, they will be escorted to a designated treatment area on the patio of the Fairview Avenue side of the building. Emergency services will be contacted
